The previous expressions of interest notice on the same that was published having the validity period expiring on 28 June 2008 has now being updated and this is the re-advertisement and all previous applicants are required to submit fresh application.

The Government of Papua New Guinea (the Government) has received loans and grants from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) to finance:

- i. the construction of a tidal basin (700 x 400 meters), a multipurpose berth, and terminal works including all buildings, storage areas, roads, drainage, water, electricity, and sewerage services, with built-in flexibility to increase the capacity further in a cost-effective manner;
- ii. relocation and livelihood improvement;
- iii. consulting services in project management, construction supervision, financial management, resettlement, and socioeconomic monitoring; and
- iv. gender-responsive programs for HIV/AIDS awareness and prevention.

The Government intends to use part of the loan proceeds to finance consulting services for construction supervision and environmental monitoring. An international consulting firm will be selected to provide a total of 249 person-months of consulting services in construction supervision (138 person-months international and 111 person-months national).

The international consulting firm will undertake the duties and responsibilities of the Engineer as defined in the construction contract. The Engineer will appoint and provide with appropriate delegated authority a suitably qualified resident engineer and other suitably qualified site engineers.

Independent Public Business Corporation (IPBC), Executing Agency for the Project will provide liaison with government agencies, provide the consultants with access to all information as may be allowed by law, and assist in obtaining the necessary work permits, visas, and other documents necessary to enable the international consultant to carry out the services under the contract.
